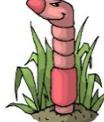

TEACHER LESSON PLAN FOR MEDIAL VOWEL /R/ STORY BUILDER #9

“MURRAY WAS WORRIED”: Place the story pages side by side in front of the student. Ask the student to answer the questions or follow the directions using a good /r/sound.

1. Who was worried? (Murray)
2. Who was Murray worried about? (his pet squirrel)
3. What was the squirrel's name? (Fergus)
4. What was Fergus nibbling on? (some dirty worms)
5. Where was Fergus playing? (in the ferns)
6. What was Fergus? (a squirrel)
7. Who had a pet named Fergus? (Murray)
8. What happened while Fergus was playing in the ferns? (he got thirsty)
9. Where did Fergus get stuck? (inside a thermos)
10. Who got thirsty, Murray or Fergus? (Fergus)
11. Read the sentences at the top and bottom of each page.
12. Ask me a question about box #7.
13. Ask me a question about box #4.
14. Read sentence #3 five times.
15. Read sentence #7 twice.
16. Read the 1st, 2nd, and 4th sentences.
17. What is your favorite sentence? Why?
